BASS FISHING TOURNAMENT (Mar.-Apr.)	P	T	W (work at event—weigh in, bar duty, or BBQ dinner) Organizing and planning the annual event held at the Lake of the Ozarks. <i>Committee meets for 3 months before tournament</i>
CHRISTMAS CHARITY (Dec.)	W	(deliver boxes to families during 2 weeks before holiday) Deliver Helping Hands items to the families referred to us by our members churches & school districts.	
COMMUNITY DIRECTORY (Jan-Mar. 2009)	P	T	Excellent opportunity to call on members or non-members to tell them about the advantages of advertising in the Bi-Annual Directory. What a great way to introduce yourself and your business to the decision makers. <i>Committee meets several time early in the yewar we publish the directory—most work done in making phone calls.</i>

Volunteer as a Greeter at meetings; encourage new members to attend a meeting and to sell 50/50—great way to meet everyone coming to meeting.
